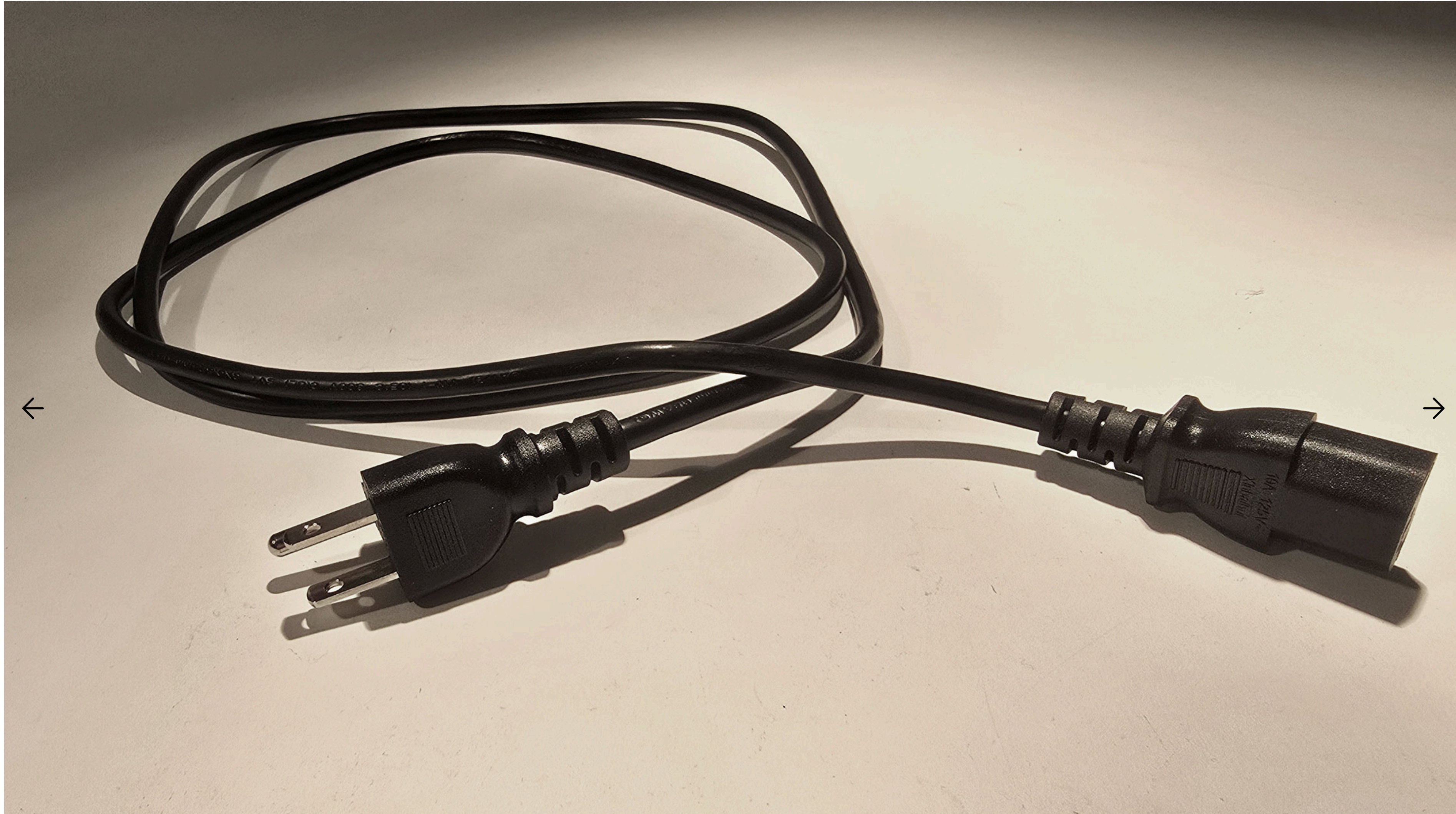


## 3 in 1

This 3 in 1 cable is a combination of a few different cables for a specific purpose. This is used for Huion's drawing tablets with a display. On one end of the cable, it has 2 USB-C connectors, on the other side, it has two USB-A connectors and an HDMI connector. This single cable provides power to the drawing tablet as well as connects the screen to the computer through the HDMI connector.

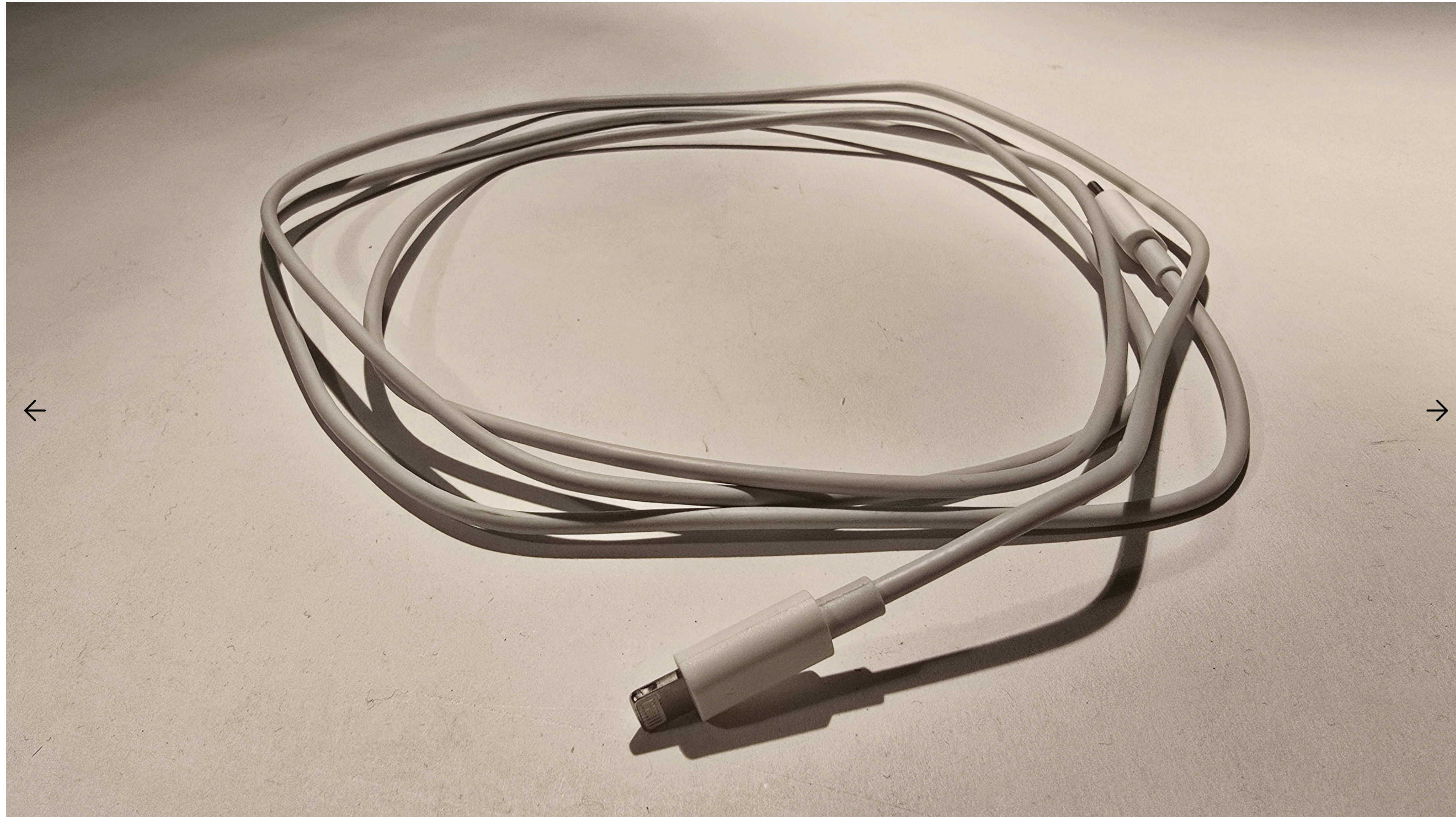


## Desktop Power

This type of cable is used to power most desktop computers. It can transmit the needed power to run a computer and all of its components. The three pronged side plugs into an outlet, while the more flat side plugs into the back of the computer.

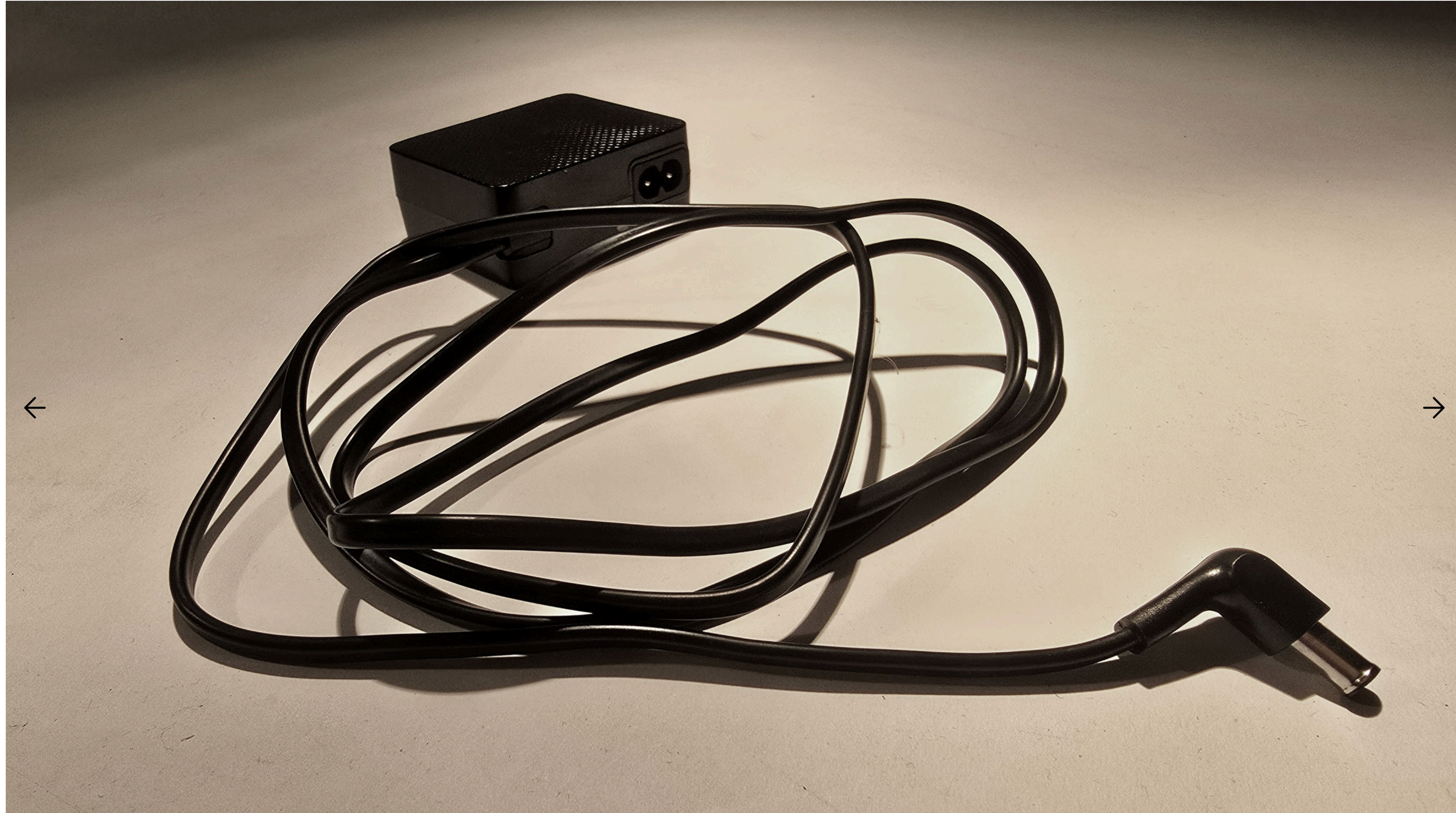


## Lightning Port

The Lightning Port cable is specifically used for older Apple devices. This cable has been phased out by the USB-C for all newer Apple devices. It was used to charge them with the other end going into a block that would go into an outlet.

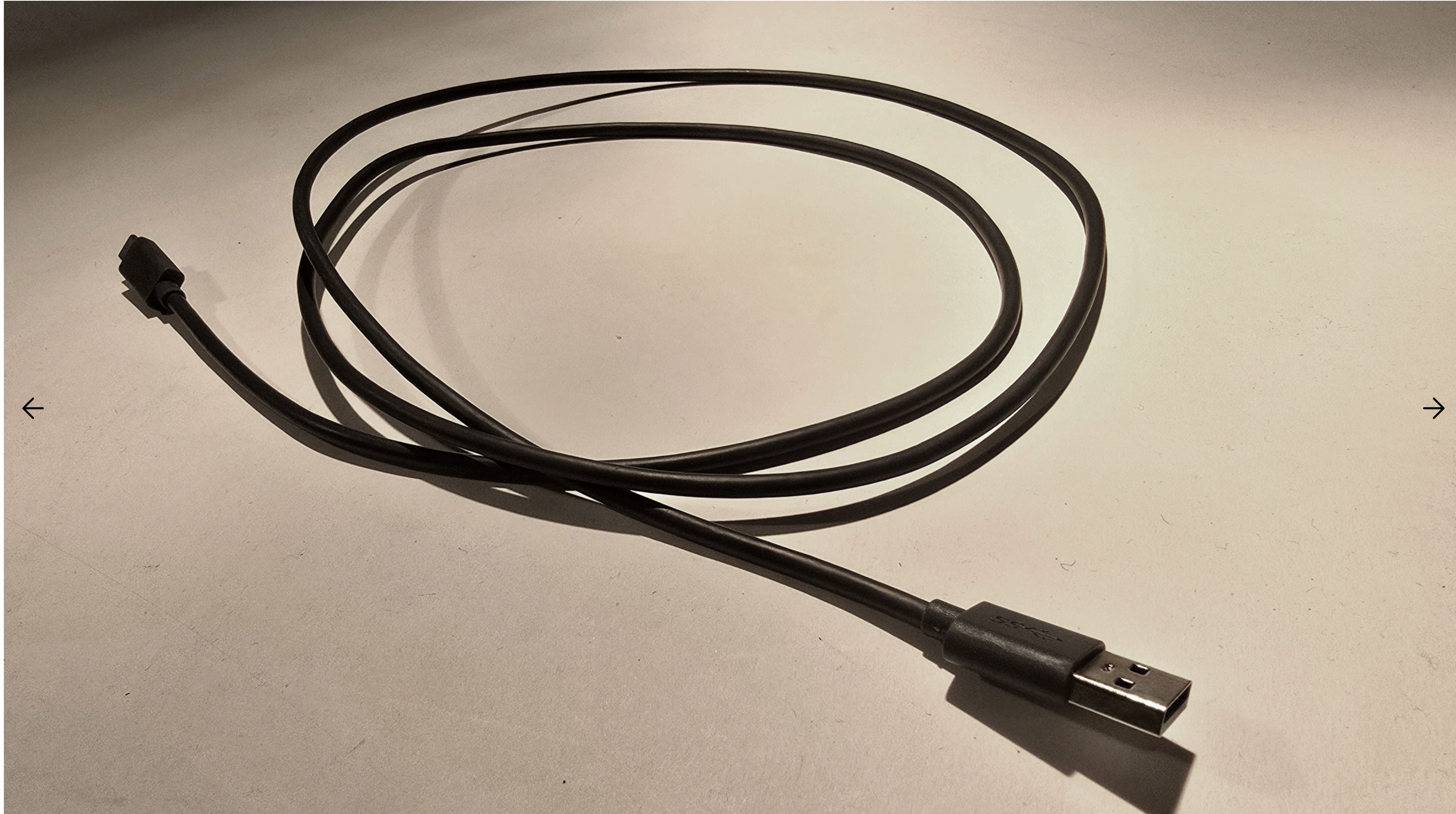


## Monitor Power

This is one of the cables that can be used to power some monitors. The block at one end of the cable is connected to another cable that then connects to an outlet to give it power. The end with the rounded connector is plugged directly into the back of the monitor to give it power.

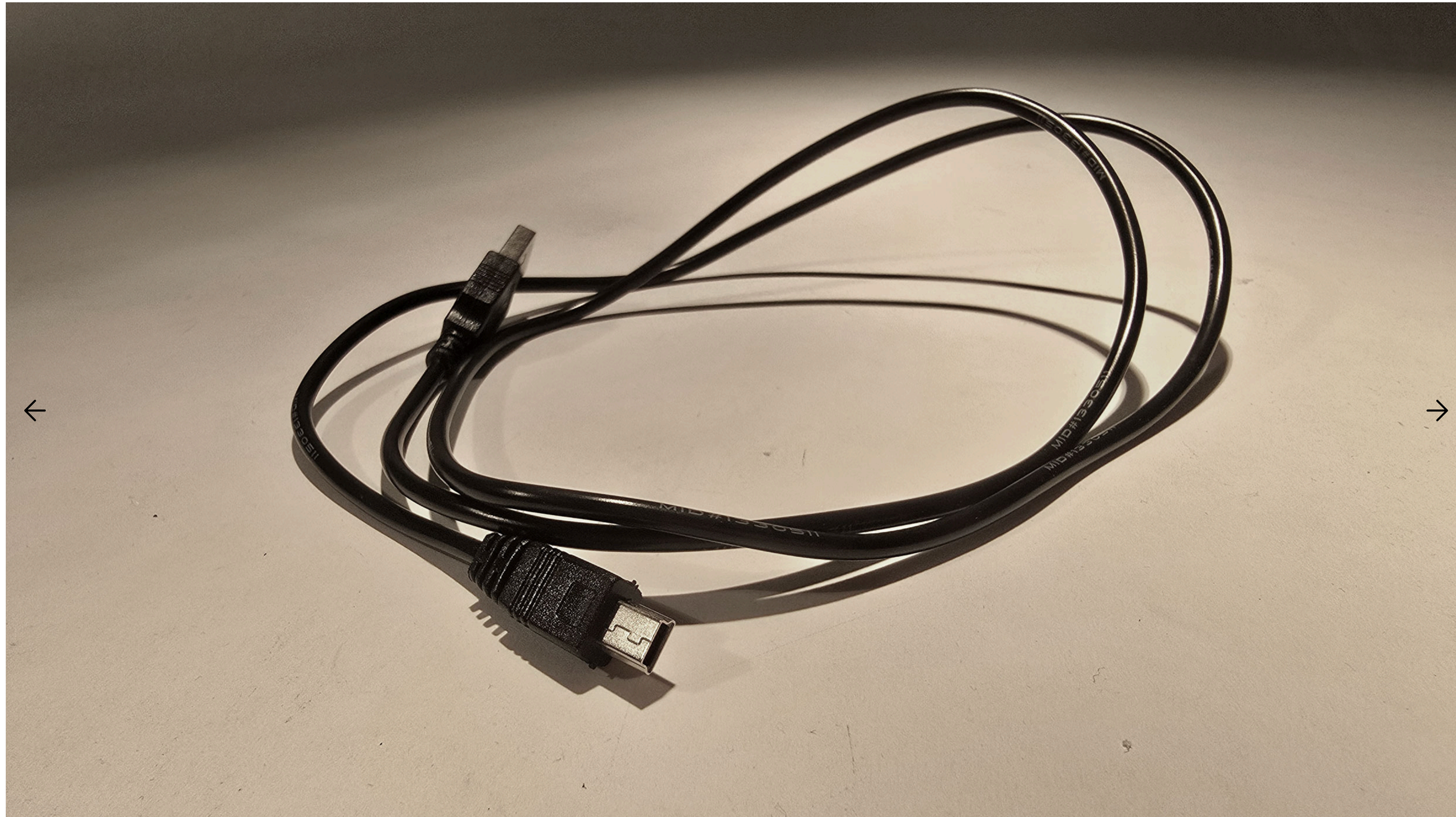


## USB-A

The USB-A cable is a versatile connector that has many uses. One use that it has is to connect computer peripherals (mice, keyboard, etc) to a computer. Another use it has is to be a connector to power adapter to charge devices.

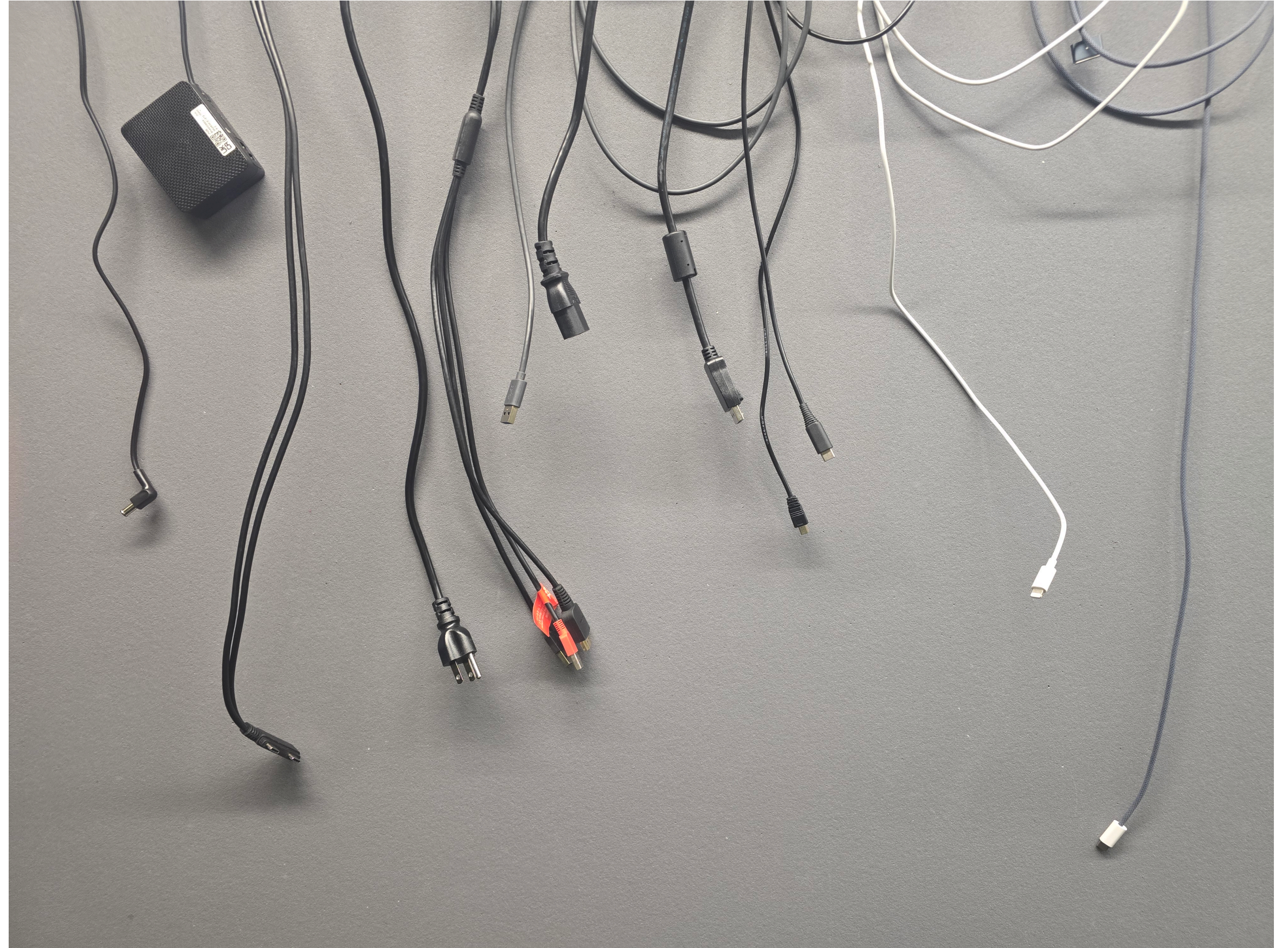
